## WHAT WE HEARD

### Gridlock

Dundas is plagued with traffic congestion, particularly during rush hour. This makes travelling frustrating for all those sharing the road - drivers, transit users and cyclists alike.

“Dundas/Hurontario is regularly clogged with traffic.”

### Run-down, neglected

You dislike aspects of the look and feel of Dundas, specifically in the Dundas and Hurontario area. You agree that many of the buildings could be given a face-lift, and that public space could be revitalized.

“Generally, the [Dundas] area looks neglected (trash on the sidewalks, illegal signs, graffiti).”

### Large scale retail

“The big box store disease is all over the spine of Dundas. Too many of them devalues the character of the historic street.”
